

South Coast Active Classrooms Primary School Challenge

Primary Teachers in Bass Coast and South Gippsland Shire (South Coast) are invited to get students involved in the Active Classrooms School Challenge!



Active classrooms incorporate movement into classroom learning. Small changes in the classroom can have a big impact on student learning, behaviour, health and contributes to their daily activity levels.

Active classrooms involve:

- Active breaks between and within learning activities
- Learning activities which involve movement
- Learning outdoors.

Empower primary school students to be leaders for change by creating and leading their own active classroom activities.

Ideas of student-led active classroom activities include:

- Active breaks that can be used as a reset between learning activities, which could be presented as movement cards, posters, videos or games
- Suggesting how movement could be incorporated into learning activities, such as jumping to count or walking to measure distances
- Leading a learning activity outdoors, such as at the oval, in shaded areas or in the school vegetable garden.

- Two winners will be selected based on the school's commitment, dedication and creativity of activities undertaken to promote active classrooms.
- The two winners will each receive a \$250 gift card to put towards supporting students to be active.
- The winners will be notified by Friday 10 October 2025.
